General Discussion: The Presidential Preference Election on March 22 was discussed. PC's were provided a paper ballot upon sign-in to vote for their preferred Presidential Candidate. The winner was John Kasich, followed by Marco Rubio, Donald Trump, and Ted Cruz, in that order.

State Convention. Our April meeting will be on April 6, a Wednesday, to elect delegates for the April 30 State Convention to elect delegates to the Republican National Convention July 18 in Cleveland, Ohio. Nominations were taken during the meeting by Jane Lynch, a member of the Nominations Committee. Nominations will close on March 23 and PC's are requested to self-nominate now by responding to the Nominations Committee Notices. Nominate yourself by either e-mail or letter. There will be two ballots, one for CD6 and the other for CD9, as our District encompasses both Congressional Districts. Proxies are permitted for the April 6 meeting and election. Any registered Republican may be nominated to go to the State Convention. Be advised that a State GOP fee of fifty (\$50) per attendee will be payable to the State GOP prior to the State Convention date on April 30.
